The 75th annual ALA SD Girls State will be held May 31st - June 5th, 2021 on the campus of the University of South Dakota, Vermillion.

## REGISTRATION FEE IS \$125.00 PER DELEGATE.

As a reminder, delegates attend the FULL session of ALA Girls State. No permission will be granted to attend other activities during the session. To receive awards and scholarships, the FULL session must be attended.

Deadline for Journalism City is APRIL 1, 2021, candidates will be contacted by April 15 of their acceptance or rejection.

Deadline for the applications is MAY 15, 2021; units should make sure that there are no last minute changes by that cut-off date.

Here's a step-by-step guide to join a Zoom meeting quickly:


Note: The same steps apply to both your desktop and your phone.



In an effort to aid in the recruitment for our South Dakota Youth Trooper Academy, I would like to invite the members of the American Legion Auxiliary to help with our efforts.

As we all know, The American Legion family has always been a huge supporter of our men and women who serve in Law Enforcement. At the same time, we support our youth, their education and helping them become better citizens. The South Dakota Youth Trooper Academy has helped nearly 200 young people reach those goals and our Law Enforcement community has gained some valuable young officers.

Legionnaires and State Troopers across the state are gearing up to visit the schools to help find those HS Juniors and Seniors who are interested in Law Enforcement or Military careers.

This year will be the nineth year we have partnered with the SDHP to host 24 select students to attend the academy held in Pierre at the SD Law Enforcement Training Center during the week of July 12-16. The Application deadline is March 21, 2021.

If you know of a high school student who may be interested in attending this year's academy, please have them see their Counselor, resource officer, or they can call me. The American Legion has established a Scholarship for an outstanding graduate and the SDHP has done so for several years as well.

This weeklong program is sponsored by local Legion Post at \$200 per student. The majority of the cost comes from the South Dakota Highway Patrol. This sponsorship leaves very little costs to the students.
