

Triple-Chocolate Cookie Balls

A special treat for the mothers who have expanded their worrying to worldwide.

½ cup Cold milk; 12 Squares Baker's Semi-Sweet Chocolate melted; 1 Pkg (3.9 oz) Chocolate Instant Pudding; 1 Pkg Baker's White Chocolate, melted; and 36 Oreos

*Stir milk and pudding mix in medium bowl with large spoon just until moistened. Immediately stir in cookie crumbs: mix well *Shape into 42 (1 inch) balls. Freeze 10 min. Dip in semi-sweet chocolate: place in single layer in shallow waxed paper-lined pan. *Refrigerate 20 minutes or until firm. Drizzle with white chocolate, refrigerate 10 min or until firm.


Father,
