#### Snickerdoodle Bread

As siblings you may "snicker" behind each other's back. But here is a recipe for the sisters of our soldiers and veterans.

1 cup softened butter; r½ cup sour cream; 1½ cups sugar; 2½ cups flour; ½ tsp salt; 2 tsp baking powder; ½ tsp ground cinnamon; 1 cup cinnamon chips (or mini chocolate chips); 3 eggs; 3 Tbsp. sugar; 1 tsp vanilla extract; 3 tsp ground cinnamon

\*Preheat over to 350 degrees and grease 5 mini loaf pans or 1 large pan. \*In a medium bowl, cream together the butter, sugar, salt and cinnamon. \*Add in the eggs, vanilla, and sour cream.

\*Add in the flour and baking powder stirring until just combined.

\*Fold in the chips; and \*Pour batter into the prepared loaf pans, filling about 2/3 full.

\*In a small bowl, combine the 3 tbsp sugar with 3 tsp ground cinnamon. Sprinkle mixture evenly on top of batter.

\*Place pans in oven and bake 30 – 35 minutes for mini loaves, 60 – 65 min if large loaf pans. \*Remove from oven and allow to cool slightly before removing from pan and serving.




Hermosa Unit 303 took first place with their 100th Birthday float at the Custer Co. Fair
