Are you a "Beverly Hills Cop" movie fan, do you remember this from the "good old day". Well, I would say **"The Heat is On"** when you look at the Department of South Dakota's membership. We are doing amazing! The lyrics state, "The heat is on, on the street, inside your head, on every beat...." I think this is you searching for our new members and for those to renew. It continues, "And the beats so loud, deep inside, The pressure's high, just to stay alive...." I take this as you working the ALA mission through your unit, community, and department. "Oh-wo-ho, oh-wo-ho," remember to rejoin, renew and recruit your membership.

We are truly, **"Caught up in the action"** when you look at everyone who is on the 100%-unit membership list. Our department is at **83.22%** and here is our January top 28 Units who have hit 100% or better! Bullhead - 183.33%, Sioux Falls 911 121.43%, Bowdle 118.52%, Cresbard 102.90%, Wilmot 102.22%, Conde 101.54%, Salem 101.41%, Wakonda 101.41%, Wessington 100.78%, Fairfax 100%, Herrick 100%, Columbia 100%, Volga 100%, Woonsocket 100%, Trent 100%, Hudson 100%, Chester 100%, Worthing 100%, Colman 100%, and Tripp 100%.

So, setting 6th in the nation, (.47% out of 2nd) we need 212 members by Midwinter to be at 85% - Keep the heat on while you are supporting our Military and Veterans.

# Message from National Headquarters

IMPORTANT + IMMEDIATE NOTICE ----PLEASE SHARE WITH OTHER MEMBERS \* Don't pay your ALA member dues through anything but www.ALAforVeterans.org. \* Please be aware of a company called Doxo, which promotes itself as an official American Legion Auxiliary national bill pay site but is NOT affiliated with us. You might stumble upon Doxo if you Google terms like "alaforveterans.org dues." This external site appears as an option in the search results and misleads members into thinking they are part of us. Don't be duped — Doxo does a nice job of branding their site to look ALA official (see screenshot).

While this payment site does work, our members have reported delayed payments, missed due dates, and additional service fees when paying through Doxo. Using our name and logo is unauthorized and makes it appear as if the service is affiliated with ALA when it is not. This has caused confusion and created hassle for some members. This is a reminder to always use the national ALA's official payment processing through the MyAuxiliary member portal at www.ALAforVeterans.org which is a quick, secure, convenient, and FREE way for members to pay their dues and update their contact information.
