
signdesign1977.club. They have been approved to use the Auxiliary, the SAL and Legion emblems.

Alma Holm, age 105, passed away Saturday, July 23, 2022, in Clark, SD. She was born on April 5, 1917.

While working at Augustana Academy in Canton, SD, she began writing letters of encouragement to several U.S. servicemen, including her future husband, Erwin Holm.

They made their home in Clark where Alma was involved with her church and many Clark community volunteer jobs. She served as a leader for the Cub Scouts, Brownies, and Girls

Scouts. She was a long-time active member and volunteer of the Red Cross, the American Cancer Society, and the Clark Historical Society.



Alma was a lifetime member of the American Legion Auxiliary and took pride in distributing poppies every Memorial Day.

The Department of South Dakota is in the top 20 of the race at the national level coming in with 4169 members for 41.31%. We need 3400 members by November 11th, that is 20 members per unit. We have many units with a flat tire, we need to air those tires up and send your membership in!

Little Eagle has already reached the winners circle with 111.11% and will be receiving \$25.00 from the Department of South Dakota. Remember your unit may also receive \$25.00 by just sending in your membership and being at 100% by November 11th. 
America the Beautiful
