

## **Senior Poppy Contest**

Categories: Centerpiece, Corsage, Wreath, Display/Wall-hanging

- 1. A Senior member may enter any or all of the categories.
- 2. All entries must use the American Legion Auxiliary poppy-large, small, or a combination.
- 3. The white label of the small poppy must be removed.
- 4. Accessories, greenery and filler may be used BUT the poppy must be predominant.
- 5. Each entry mut have the following information attached behind or under the arrangement, hidden from immediate view of the judge.
  - a. The member's name and Auxiliary ID number
  - b. The name and number of the Member's Unit
  - c. The category for the entry
- 6. All work must be done by the Unit member entering the contest.
- 7. Entries will be judged at Mid-Winter and should be checked in by 8:00 Saturday.
- 8. Entries will be judged using the following criteria:

25% Labeling, proper materials, following directions

50% Predominance of the Poppy

25% Design and creativity—Use of the Department President's theme for the year will be taken into consideration.



## **Junior Poppy Contest**

Categories: Centerpiece/Display, Corsage, Tray Favor, Wreath

- 1. A Junior member may enter any or all of the categories.
- 2. All entries must use the American Legion Auxiliary poppy-large, small, or a combination.
- 3. The white label of the small poppy must be removed.
- 4. Accessories, greenery and filler may be used BUT the poppy must be predominant.
- 5. Each entry mut have the following information attached behind or under the arrangement, hidden from immediate view of the judge.
  - a. The member's name and Auxiliary ID number
  - b. The name and number of the Member's Unit
  - c. The category for the entry
- 6. All work must be done by the Unit member entering the contest.
- 7. Entries will be judged at State Convention and should be checked in by 8:00 Saturday.
- 8. Entries will be judged using the following criteria: 25% Labeling, proper materials, following directions

25% Predominance of the Poppy

50% Design and creativity—Use of the Department President's theme for the year will be taken into consideration.
